## **Benedictions**

This is not an exhaustive list of Biblical benedictions, but I believe it covers all those that I use in the Prayer Conference. As you get into a habit of using them, you'll find others as you read scripture.

### ***Ps. 41:13***

Blessed be the Lord God of Israel  
From everlasting to everlasting!  
Amen and Amen.

### ***Numbers 6:24-26***

The Lord bless you and keep you;  
The Lord make His face shine upon you, And be gracious to you;  
The Lord lift up His countenance upon you, and give you peace." '  
(NKJV)

### ***2 Corinthians 13:14***

The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all. Amen.  
(NKJV)

### ***Jude 24-25***

To him who is able to keep you from falling and to present you before his glorious presence without fault and with great joy- to the only God our Savior be glory, majesty, power and authority, through Jesus Christ our Lord, before all ages, now and forevermore! Amen.  
(NIV)

### **Matthew 6:9-13**

Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.  
Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.  
Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.  
And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil:  
For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.

### ***Ps 139:23-24***

Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts:  
And see if there be any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting. KJV

### ***Ps 143:8***

Cause me to hear Your lovingkindness in the morning, For in You do I trust; Cause me to know the way in which I should walk, For I lift up my soul to You.
