Here are several prayer times to help you get started with a guided prayer time. The first five are the ones I use in the *Journey Into the Presence of God* conference of prayer.

## 1. Prayer time

(Prayer Conference – Talking With God)

### ***Scriptural Meditation:***

Ps. 18:6

In my distress I called upon the Lord  
And cried out to my God  
He heard my voice from His temple  
And my cry came before Him, even to His ears.

### ***Biblical Visualization: Throne Room of Heaven***

Throne Rm. Of Heaven

### ***Prayer by Suggestion***

Praise – Thanksgiving  
Confession – Penitence  
Burden in blanket of faith  
Person next to you  
My ministry  
Church –  
Missionaries

### ***Benediction:***

Ps. 19:14

Let the words of my mouth,  
And the meditation of my heart,  
Be acceptable in your sight,  
Oh Lord, my strength and redeemer.

## 2. Prayer time

(Prayer Conference – Great Commission of Prayer)

### ***Scriptural Meditation:***

Matt 18:20 For where two or three are gathered together in My name, I am there in the midst of them." NKJV

### ***Biblical Visualization: Peter's Living Room***

The passage we're looking at today probably took place in **Peter's living room**. Imagine Jesus is **teaching** a lesson on praying about their **most difficult** problems. Now He asks them to **split up** for prayer.

**Peter** and his **wife**  
**John** and his brother **James**  
**Martha** and her sister **Mary**  
**Mary** the **mother** of Jesus and **Mary Magdalene**  
**You** and your prayer **partner**

As they pray, **Jesus** goes from group to group. He **listens**, puts a hand on each one's **shoulder**, and **prays** about their problem. **What does He pray?**

### ***Benediction:***

2 Cor 13:14 The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all. Amen. NKJV

### 3. Prayer time

(Prayer Conference – The Forgotten Altar)

#### ***Scriptural Meditation:***

Ps 100:1-5

1 Make a joyful noise unto the Lord, all ye lands.

2 Serve the Lord with gladness: come before his presence with singing.

3 Know ye that the Lord he is God: it is he that hath made us, and not we ourselves; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture.

4 Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name.

5 For the Lord is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his truth endureth to all generations.

Alternate:

Ps 141:2

2 Let my prayer be set before You as incense, The lifting up of my hands as the evening sacrifice. NKJV

#### ***Biblical Visualization: Pilgrimage to Temple Courts***

Family on pilgrimage to temple

- **Camping** along the road, **singing & eating** around camp **fire**
- Entering gates with thanksgiving and courtyard with praise
- Rams **horns**
- The **sacrifice**
- The **prayer** at time of **evening** offering
- Go to the **Western Wall**
  - Do you feel His **presence**?
  - Does your spirit long to be **close to Him**?

Confession – Penitence

## 4. Prayer time

(Prayer Conference – Prayer Basics)

### ***Scriptural Meditation:***

Jer 1:5a "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you;"—NKJV

### ***Biblical Visualization: In The Beginning***

Gen 1:1-2 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. 2 The earth was **without form, and void**; and darkness was on the face of the deep. **And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters.** NKJV

As God pondered the actions He was about to take; He could already see:

- **Majesty** of the **Rocky Mountains** in winter.
- The **beauty** of a **sunset** over the Pacific.
- The **glory** of the **blue bonnets** covering the plains.

He could also see:

- **Sin** and all that goes with it.
- **War and hate**
- Child **abuse, murder, torture.**
- The **Cross!**

**Why** did He do it? Because He could **see you**. He was determined to give you **life** and the opportunity to have an eternal **relationship** with you.

### ***Prayer by Suggestion***

God has paid an unbelievable **price** to give you life. **Thank** Him.

**Praise** Him for something beautifully in creation.

**Confession** – Penitence

**Person** next to you

**Church** to be a house of prayer

### ***Benediction:***

Num 6:24-26

"The LORD bless you and keep you;

The LORD make His face shine upon you, And be gracious to you;

The LORD lift up His countenance upon you, And give you peace." NKJV

## 5. Prayer time




(Prayer Conference – Prayer Guide Techniques)

### ***Scriptural Meditation:***

John 21:6 And He said to them, "Cast the net on the right side of the boat, and you will find some." So they cast, and now they were not able to draw it in because of the multitude of fish. NKJV

### ***Biblical Visualization: Breakfast with Jesus***

**Breakfast** around a **campfire** with Jesus recalls Peter and calls you to a:

-  A new life
-  A new calling
-  A new direction

### ***Prayer by Suggestion***

Praise – Thanksgiving

What has God taught you?  
Has your response been worthy of Him?  
Have you acted on it?  
Ask Him to instruct you.

Person next to you  
Church to be a House of Prayer

### ***Benediction:***

Rom 15:13 Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit. NKJV

Jude 24-25

24 Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling, And to present you faultless Before the presence of His glory with exceeding joy,  
25 To God our Savior, Who alone is wise, Be glory and majesty, Dominion and power, Both now and forever. Amen. NKJV

## 6. Prayer Time

### ***Scriptural Meditation:***

Nahum 1:7

7 The LORD is good, A stronghold in the day of trouble; And He knows those who trust in Him. NKJV

### ***Biblical Visualization: Mary & Joseph to Egypt***

Mary and Joseph on the road to Egypt in the night.

What did they talk about?

Who could they trust?

### ***Prayer by Suggestion:***

What are you afraid of this morning?

Who are you going to trust?

Praise Him for beauty – song birds, blue sky with white clouds, quiet

Confess and repent – lack of trust

Missionary family – after Christmas let down

Struggling someone you know – opportunity to bless

### ***Benediction:***

Heb 13:20-21

Now may the God of peace who brought up our Lord Jesus from the dead, that great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, 21 make you complete in every good work to do His will, working in you what is well pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory forever and ever. Amen. NKJV

## 7. Prayer Time

### ***Scriptural Meditation:***

Ps 33:11

11 The counsel of the LORD stands forever,  
The plans of His heart to all generations. NKJV

### ***Biblical Visualization: Abraham on death bed***

Abraham on his death bed  
Did he have regrets? Probably.  
Had he been faithful to his calling? Yes.

### ***Prayer by Suggestions:***

Praise for beauty  
Confess unfaithfulness to your calling  
Ask God for worthy life goals and promises  
Commit to reading His Word  
Pray for those affected most by your life decisions

### ***Benediction:***

Ps. 41:13

Blessed be the Lord God of Israel  
From everlasting to everlasting!  
Amen and Amen.

## 8. Prayer time

Come to front, kneel by chair, sit or stand (several minutes)

### ***Scriptural Meditation:***

Ex 15:2a

The LORD is my strength and song,  
And He has become my salvation;  
He is my God, and I will praise Him; NKJV

Moses said those words after deliverance at the Red Sea  
What monster is chasing you today?

### ***Biblical Visualization: Israelites at Red Sea***

Can you imagine yourself among the Israelites at the edge of the Red Sea?  
Perhaps you can swim, but not far enough.

### ***Prayer by Suggestion***

As you stand there; do this:

Thank God for past victories – in your life, others, or Bible.

Thank God for life that's real.

Confession – Penitence

Walk through that Red Sea then turn around and watch the sea come crashing down on  
that monster.

Thank God in advance for the day when you will see that victory.

Let Moses words become yours.

### ***Benediction:***

Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart

Be acceptable in Your sight,

O LORD, my strength and my Redeemer. Ps 19:14 (NKJV)

## 9. Prayer Time

### ***Scriptural Meditation:***

Rev 19:1-2b

After these things I heard a loud voice of a great multitude in heaven, saying, "Alleluia! Salvation and glory and honor and power belong to the Lord our God! 2 For true and righteous are His judgments..."

### ***Biblical Visualization – Saints in Heaven say alleluia!***

That takes place as the Great Tribulation is coming to a close. Imagine a hundred million saints shouting those words in one voice. Do you feel the ground shaking?

### ***Prayer by Suggestion***

Praise God for something beautiful in creation

Confession

Many Christians have died violent deaths in the last couple of weeks (Kenya, India) some for putting up Christmas decorations.

- ✚ Prayer for their surviving families: wives, children, parents
- ✚ Pray for those who's homes are gone
- ✚ Pastors who are constantly watched and slandered

Pray for Christ's return and the end of this evil age of Satan's rule on earth.

### ***Benediction***

Rev 22:20b-21

He who testifies to these things says, "Surely I am coming quickly."

~~Amen~~. Even so, come, Lord Jesus!

The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen. NKJV

## 10. Prayer time

### ***Scriptural Meditation:***

Matt 9:36

36 But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion for them, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd. NKJV

### ***Biblical Visualization: Pool of Bethesda***

Visit the Pool of **Bethesda**. If it weren't for all these sick, crippled and blind people; it would be **beautiful**. Perhaps there should be a law against **loitering**?

Do you see that man? He's been crippled like that for **38 years**. So pitiful!

Do you see **Jesus** enter and stand in the shadows of the beautiful porch?

What's He doing? Is He **looking** for someone? Yes, the most pitiful person here.

John 5:6

When Jesus saw him lying there, and knew that he already had been in that condition a long time, He said to him, "**Do you want to be made whole?**" NKJV

### ***Prayer by Suggestion***

**Are you** the most pitiful person here in this beautiful place? Perhaps you've **come here** for years or even decades **hoping** someday to be healed of that most difficult struggle in your life.

**Is Jesus asking** you right now; do you want to be made whole?

Jesus would find this man later and warn him to "**sin no more**" lest something worse happen to him.

Can you see yourself through Jesus eyes?

Confession

Penitence

### ***Benediction:***

Rom.15:13

13 Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit. NKJV

## 11. Prayer time

### ***Scriptural Meditation:***

John 1:9

9 That was the true Light which gives light to every man coming into the world. NKJV

### ***Biblical Visualization: the lamb of morning sacrifice***

Three places:

Outside Bethlehem – lamb selected “a lamb of God”

Temple – lamb slain for the morning sacrifices – “the lamb is slain”

Jordan – John sees Jesus coming – “Behold the Lamb...”

### ***Prayer by Suggestion***

Thank you Lord for:

Ending the sacrificial system

Showing us how to live

Being the lamb

### ***Benediction:***

Heb 13:20-21

Now may the God of peace who brought up our Lord Jesus from the dead, that great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, 21 make you complete in every good work to do His will, working in you what is well pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory forever and ever. Amen. NKJV

## 12. Prayer time

John 18:1-2

### ***Scriptural Meditation:***

John 18:1-2

When Jesus had spoken these words, He went out with His disciples over the Brook Kidron, where there was a garden, which He and His disciples entered. 2 And Judas, who betrayed Him, also knew the place; for Jesus often met there with His disciples. NKJV

### ***Biblical Visualization: Jesus' garden of prayer***

Garden within an orchard

Walk paths

Flower beds

Places to sit & pray

Sit in the quiet and listen

Mans voice maybe 100yds away

Seems famialiar

Other voices asking questions

It's Jesus and apostles

What do you want to ask?

Are you willing to:

get close enough?

Come often enough?

Hear His answer?

### ***Prayer by Suggestion***

#### ***Benediction:***

2 Corinthians 13:14

The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all. Amen.

(NKJV)

## **13. Prayer time**

Come to front, kneel by chair, sit or stand (several minutes)

### ***Scriptural Meditation:***

John 17:26

And I have declared to them Your name, and will declare it, that the love with which You loved Me may be in them, and I in them." NKJV

### ***Biblical Visualization: upper room – Jesus prayer***

Standing in the courtyard outside the upper room, listening to Jesus pray for His followers as they are about to begin a pilgrimage so difficult that almost every one of them will be martyred.

Jesus knows what the rest of your life is going to be like too. What do you think He would be praying for you?

### ***Prayer by Suggestion:***

Praise – Thanksgiving  
Confession – Penitence  
Person next to you  
My ministry

Missionaries

### ***Benediction:***

Ps.19:14

Let the words of my mouth,  
And the meditation of my heart,  
Be acceptable in your sight,  
Oh Lord, my strength and redeemer.

## 14. Prayer time

What is the theme of the story of Gideon?

- ✚ How many said putting out the fleece to know the will of God?
- ✚ How many said God's deliverance using the weak to defeat the strong?

Does your answer reveal anything about your present relationship with God?

### ***Scriptural Meditation:***

Judg 6:15-16

So he said to Him, "O my Lord, how can I save Israel? Indeed my clan is the weakest in Manasseh, and I am the least in my father's house."

And the LORD said to him, "Surely I will be with you, and you shall defeat the Midianites as one man." NKJV

### ***Biblical Visualization: Standing with Gideon***

Standing among the 300 men of Gideon watching 32,000 leave.

What do you feel?

### ***Prayer by Suggestion***

Praise God for something great he's done for you or someone you know in the past.

Thank Him for the good in your life now.

What is your greatest fear right now? Explain your fear to the Lord.

Ask Him to use your weakness to do something good by His power.

Pray this verse with me silently: 2 Cor 12:9b-10

I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me. That is why, for Christ's sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong. NIV

### ***Benediction:***

Rom.15:13

13 Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit. NKJV

## 15. Prayer time

### ***Scriptural Meditation:***

Nahum 1:7

7 The LORD is good, A stronghold in the day of trouble; And He knows those who trust in Him. NKJV

### ***Biblical Visualization: Joseph sold into slavery***

Joseph sold into slavery by his brothers; on his way to Egypt

What was he thinking

Who could he trust – nobody

Did he still trust in God? evadently

### ***Prayer by Suggestion***

Thank God for your freedom and liberty.

What is trying to enslave you today?

Have you failed to trust God? Do you need to repent?

Turn that over to God and ask His help.

Who is praying with you about this struggle? Pray for them.

### ***Benediction:***

Heb 13:20-21

Now may the God of peace who brought up our Lord Jesus from the dead, that great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, 21 make you complete in every good work to do His will, working in you what is well pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory forever and ever. Amen. NKJV
